FINANCE & FACILITIES

- In order to maintain a safe and high-quality learning environment, we will assess the school's major capital needs and develop a multi-year plan to acquire the necessary funding needed to invest thoughtfully into our school building.
- We will develop a five-year, right-size tuition plan and a conservative fundraising plan. This plan will project for future enrollment and expenses, including projected scholarship support, in order to ensure that an STA education is affordable for all families.

ACADEMICS & INSTRUCTION

- In a continued effort to be inclusive of all learners and to ensure all students grow academically, socially, and emotionally, we will evaluate the existing supports for students to help identify additional support we can include in our education program.
- We will provide diverse enrichment opportunities for STA students throughout the academic year and summer. These will include project-based learning, service learning, grade level "traditions", and "specials" courses.
- In order to promote a community of teachers committed to professional growth, we will thoughtfully plan teacher professional development.

ACCESSIBILITY

- Our school will focus on meeting the needs of all learners. STA
 will strengthen and support our inclusive learning program,
 work to identify additional support staff, and provide teachers
 with professional development around differentiation and
 inclusion.
- In partnership with members of our school's parish, school
 parents, and partners in the Catholic community, our school will
 demonstrate our Catholic identity by developing service
 opportunities for students and families.
- Because a parent school connection is important for student success, STA will provide families with opportunities for family learning. We will align family curriculum nights with school initiatives and develop a communication plan to support parent involvement of student learning.
- In an effort to continually support all families and to ensure each child's time at STA is productive, we will evaluate our school's extended day program and its impact on the school mission, student homework, and family life.
- Our school will develop a program and communication plan to inform parents on high school options, high school admissions processes, and resources for scholarships in order to support a seamless transition for our students from STA onto high school.

COMMUNICATION & ENGAGEMENT

- Existing families are a key to the STA community and the school's success. We will improve communication and engagement to increase retention, foster parent and student ambassadors, and increase parent and student awareness of all things STA.
- In order to increase community engagement and awareness, we will focus on improving branding for the school, participation in or creation of community events and programs and utilizing the school's physical space to interact with the community.
- STA will work to improve alumni and donor engagement through improved identification, communication, and collaboration with the STA alumni base, individuals and businesses that support STA and engage them in the school's mission of educating God's children in extraordinary variety.
- We will strive to partner with local institutions and businesses, including universities and high schools to increase academic excellence and support our students and families going through the high school admissions process.
